1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 BNSS, 2023 seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 6 not to harass and humiliate the petitioner by calling him at office of respondent Nos.4 to 6 and by giving him threats.

Learned State counsel, at the very outset, on instructions from Inspector Rajbinder Kaur, submits that nothing survives in the present petition as the veracity of the allegations made by the petitioner has been thoroughly investigated and it has been concluded that no cognizable offence is made out against him. He further submits that the matter has been referred back to the department concerned and recovery, if any, to be made has to be decided by the concerned department.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.
