This is Second petition under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 seeking inherent jurisdiction of the Hon'ble High Court for the issuance of an appropriate direction to the Lower Appellate Court i.e., ASJ, Jhajjar for speedy and expeditious disposal of the appeal no. CRA-66-2023 titled as "*Sumitra v/s State of Haryana and another*" filed by the respondent No.1, pending for 10.07.2025 before the Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Jhajjar since 2023 i.e. pending from more than 02 years, arising out of Criminal Complaint COMI-22 of 2015 titled "Ombir v/s Prem Kumar and another" u/s 406, 420, 467, 464, 468, 471, 506, 120-B/34 IPC and 138 of N.I, Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention of this Court to the zimni orders attached at Annexure P-4 collectively to assert that the arguments are not being advanced by the appellant namely Sumitra in appeal in question.
