Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent(s) for not complying the order dated 19.12.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-34677-2024 titled as “Anita Jain @ Anita Kesar vs. State of Punjab and others”, vide which the petition was disposed of on the basis of statement made by learned counsel for the State that “*....in case the representation which is appended with the present petition as Annexure P/7 has been received from the petitioner, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any relief, the same will be granted to the petitioner otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner for her information and necessary action.*”



Learned counsel for the respondent-State has filed the Compliance Report dated 07.7.2025 by way of affidavit of Shri Kumar Rahul, IAS, Principal Secretary, Department of Health and Family Welfare, Punjab. Learned counsel for the State on the basis of the said Compliance Report and on instructions, submits that necessary compliance has been made, while passing a speaking order dated 13.6.2025 (Annexure R-1) passed by the Senior Medical Officer I/c Sub Divisional Hospital, Dera Bassi, District Sahibzada Ajit Singh Nagar; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Copy of the aforesaid Compliance Report by way of affidavit dated 07.7.2025 produced by the learned counsel for the respondent-State is taken on record. Copy thereof is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

Dismissed as not pressed.

The petitioner would be at liberty to challenge the aforesaid speaking order dated 13.6.2025 (Annexure R-1) as per law.

Rule stands discharged.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stands disposed of.
