SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under article 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer that this Hon'ble Court may issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2-HPSC to decide the legal notice dated 17.08.2025 regarding clash of examination dates for the post of Superintendent (Legal) Group B and Assistant District Attorney, Prosecution (ADA) with a further direction to quash/modify the examination schedule advertised by respondent No.2.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that the screening test for both the examination for the post of Superintendent (Legal) Group B and Assistant District Attorney, Prosecution (ADA) would be conducted on the same date i.e 02.11.2025 and in that eventuality, the petitioner being fully eligible having possessed requisite qualification to compete for both the said posts will not be in a position to appear for both the posts.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Kanwal Goyal, Advocate, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-HPSC and on instructions, he submits that there is no bar for the petitioner to compete for the two separate posts i.e Superintendent



(Legal) Group B and Assistant District Attorney, Prosecution (ADA) since syllabus and screening for both the examination is common.

4. In the light of above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not have any grouse left to be addressed by this Court and seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

5. Prayer is accepted.

6. Dismissed as withdrawn.
