1. By way of present writ petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of direction to the respondents to release the retiral benefits of the petitioner including provident fund along with admissible interest and pension along with interest @ 18% from the due date till its realization.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions from the petitioner, prays that at this stage, he will be satisfied if direction is given to respondent No.2 to treat the instant writ petition as a representation and decide the same within a time bound manner.
