Mr. Subhash Godara, Advocate appears on behalf of Mr. Dalip Kumar Tuteja, Advocate for the appellants and files his memo of appearance, which is taken on record. He states that he has been authorized not only by the claimants/appellants but also by Mr. DK Tuteja, Advocate to settle this appeal.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.5,30,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. As per statement, the entire enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1-Smt. Urmila Devi W/o late Sh. Satyadev, for & on behalf of all the claimants, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a cheque in the sum of Rs.5,30,000/- favoring appellant No.1-Smt. Urmila Devi W/o late Sh. Satyadev with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of six weeks from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the counsel for the appellant.

Pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, stands disposed of.
