1. Instant appeal has been filed against the order, dated 05.02.2025, passed by learned Special Court, Rupnagar, rejecting anticipatory bail to the appellant in case FIR No.5 dated 08.01.2025, registered under Sections 3(1)(s) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 at Police Station City Rupnagar, Tehsil and District Rupnagar, Punjab.
2. By virtue of order dated 27.03.2025, while granting interim protection, the appellant was directed to join the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that the appellant has joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the same and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.



4. Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Lachhman Dass, has affirmed the fact that the appellant has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

5. Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the appellant.

6. In view of the above, the present appeal is allowed and the order dated 27.03.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
