The appellant has challenged the order dated 27.03.2025 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar whereby his anticipatory bail application in case FIR No.71 dated 02.09.2024, registered under Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, at Police Station City Kurali, District SAS Nagar, has been dismissed.
