SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in respect of FIR No. 327 dated 26.07.2024, Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, where initially offences under Sections 112 (2), 115 (2), 126 (2), 190, 191 (3), 304 (2) and 351 (3) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023 were registered, but subsequently, on disclosure of various head injuries caused on the person of the complainant, offence under Section 117 (2) of BNS, 2023 (equivalent to Section 325 IPC) was registered on 08.10.2024.

2. Status report dated 16.08.2025, filed by way of affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, is taken on record.

3. The petitioner is enjoying fruits of interim anticipatory bail since 14.01.2025 and has not misused the conditions, subject to which interim bail was granted. Petitioner has co-operated in the investigation. However, no



charge sheet has yet been filed against petitioner Lakhvinder Ram alias Lakhvinder Singh alias Lucky.

4. On the strength of the fact that petitioner has no criminal antecedents, but considering the fact that he is the main accused, who along with his co-accused allegedly inflicted injuries on the vital part of body of the injured-complainant, this Court is though inclined to confirm interim anticipatory bail granted to the petitioner, but with stringent conditions.

5. Accordingly, the order dated 14.01.2025, granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 50,000/- each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer, subject to the following condition :

- (i) the petitioner shall plant 10 saplings of indigenous plants at a public place and submit proof in that regard by way of photographs before the concerned Police Station within a period of 15 days and if there is no such intimation submitted or intimation is found to be incorrect, then the State can move an application for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.

6. The petition stands allowed.
