1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 for transfer of investigation in complaint registered by respondent No.3 vide UID No.521858 dated 04.02.2025 and complaint registered by the petitioner vide UID No.539286 dated 27.02.2025 to any other district in the State of Punjab other than District Ferozepur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the daughter of the petitioner, whose marriage was solemnized with respondent No.5 on 09.11.2020, was subjected to harassment and cruelty on the demand of dowry. Subsequently, respondent No.5, instead of improving his ways, started demanding Rs.35 lakhs from the petitioner, which she refused to pay. Thereafter, respondent No.5 started threatening the petitioner and even filed a false complaint to implicate the petitioner and her family members. It is



submitted that though the petitioner and her husband have been called multiple times for investigation and have also faced harassment caused at the behest of the private respondents. It was for this reason that the petitioner filed a detailed complaint before S.S.P, Ferozepur on 27.02.2025 (Annexure P-1), however, no action has been taken till date on the same and on the subsequent follow up mails. The complaints dated 04.02.2025 and 22.03.2025 also met with similar fate. It is apprehended by the petitioner that proper investigation would not be conducted in the case, and therefore, it is prayed that the investigation be transferred before investigating agency of any other district.

3. Per contra, learned counsel for the private respondents No.4 and 6 to 8 submits that respondent No.4 had moved an application dated 04.02.2025 against the petitioner and her family members, who are the in-laws of his son (respondent No.5) for committing fraud upon them and duping them of Rs.30 lakhs. It is submitted that the present petition has no merits, and has been filed only to cause undue harassment to the private respondents.

4. Learned State counsel while relying upon the contents of the status report dated 15.07.2025, submits that it is a case of version and cross-version, wherein complaints have been moved by either side. It is submitted that all the applications moved by the petitioner and her family members are pending for inquiry before the concerned authorities and the same would be decided in fair and non partisan manner, strictly in accordance with law.

Relevant paras of the status report are reproduced as under:-

*4. That the deponent submits that Jagtar Singh, Son of Joginder Singh (Respondent No. 4), father of Manpreet Singh moved an application bearing UID No. 521858 dated 04.02.2025 before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur against the*



*in-laws family of Manpreet Singh namely Paramjit Kaur (mother in law of Manpreet Singh), Makhan Singh (father in law of Manpreet Singh), Davinder Kaur (wife of Manpreet Singh), Amanpreet Singh alias Amna (brother in law of Manpreet Singh), Sunita alias Jaspreet Kaur (mediator in the marriage) for committing fraud and cheating of Rs. 30 Lacs, obtained fraudulently from the family of boy and for marrying Manpreet Singh by showing fake BSC (Non-Medical Degree).*

5. *That the aforesaid application bearing UID No. 521858 dated 04.02.2025 is pending with the Superintendent of Police (Inv) Ferozepur for enquiry and report. Similarly, the application bearing UID No. 539286 dated 27.02.2025 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioner against the family of boy Manpreet Singh is also pending for enquiry before Superintendent of Police (Inv) Ferozepur. Further the applications filed by Davinder Kaur, Daughter of petitioner and her husband Makhan Singh is also pending for enquiry before the Superintendent of Police (Inv) Ferozepur, as all the complaints/applications pertains to the same subject matter and allegations and counter allegations of boy and girl's family against each other.*

6. *That the deponent submits that the petitioner herein has levelled false allegations against the Police of District Ferozepur that the Local Authorities of District Ferozepur are under the influence of respondent no. 4."*

5. Heard.

6. This Court vide order dated 30.07.2025 had directed the parties to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for settlement of the dispute between the parties.

7. Pursuant to aforesaid order, report of Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court has been received as per which, parties could not arrive at an amicable settlement.

8. As can be evinced from the perusal of the material on record, it comes out that allegations and counter allegations have been levelled by either side. The representations/complaints moved by the petitioner and her family members before the concerned authorities are pending for inquiry. Goes



without saying that it is expected of the concerned officials that they would conduct a free and fair investigation into the matter. The learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to point out any arbitrary action or inaction on the part of the investigating agency, other than the mere apprehension of the petitioner, that would warrant interference by this Court.

9. Accordingly, the petition, being without any merits, stands dismissed.

10. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
