HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel representing respondent Nos.1 and 2 on instructions submits that the arrears towards benefit payable to the petitioner have been released in his favour till 01.07.2016, whereas the interest for those benefits till 01.07.2016 and the actual benefits payable thereof along with interest shall be released within eight (08) weeks from today.

2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by the respondent(s), learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

3. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

4. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
