1. The present petition under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.170 dated 24.11.2024, under Sections 109, 126(2), 191 (3) and 190 of BNS, 2023 and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, (offence under Section 103 BNS, 2023 added later on, vide rapat No.17 dated 24.11.2024), registered at P.S.Makhu, District Ferozepur.
2. Learned State counsel informs that on 29.04.2025, petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender. Therefore, the present petition is not maintainable.
3. Faced with the situation, counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of present petition with liberty to avail alternative remedy as available under the concerned law.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as sought and recorded here-above.
