1. The present contempt petition has been filed alleging violation of order dated 31.05.2024 passed in CWP-14250-2024 (Annexure P-2) whereby it was directed that:

“Accordingly, in view of the above, with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No. 2- Sub Divisional Engineer, SDE Water Supply & Sanitation, Distt. Fatehgarh Sahib, to consider and decide the legal notice dated 30.12.2023 (Annexure P-1) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

2. Learned State counsel submits that compliance report dated 26.08.2025 by way of affidavit of Ishan Kaushal, Executive Engineer, Water Supply & Sanitation Division, Fatehgarh Sahib, a copy thereof has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. He further informs that in compliance of the directions dated 31.05.2024 of the Writ Court, a speaking order dated 06.02.2025, after giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner (Annexure R-1) has been passed.

3. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same stands **disposed of**.

4. Rule stands discharged.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
