The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking direction to respondent no. 2 i.e. DGP, Punjab as well as SSP/ Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to take appropriate strict legal action against the guilty police officials who have been unduly harassing the petitioner due to pending of FIR and they are unduly victimizing the petitioner to sought compromise with the accused persons and even they are not issuing/ clearing the PCC (Police Clearing Certificate) and not issued passport while alleging that there is FIR No. 210 dated 20.07.2022 under Sections 406, 420, 120B IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professional (Regulation) Act, 2014, P.S. Rama Mandi, Jalandhar i.e. Annexure P-1 is pending and also to impose penalty against the guilty police officials as the police has neither completed the investigation nor any steps have been taken to conclude the same.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the instant petition at this stage and prays for withdrawal of the same since according to the information provided by learned State counsel challan in the instant case stands furnished on 25.11.2024 wherein charges were also framed subsequently on 24.12.2024.

As far as the question of release of Police Clearance Certificate is concerned that also stands released on 22.12.2024.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
