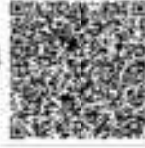

The petitioner has filed the present writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to respondents No.4 and 5 to release the salary as per the fixation of minimum wages (DC Rate) as well as increment @ 6% as per the orders dated 09.03.2015 (Annexure P-10) and Employee Provident Funds @ 12% under the Employees Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Act, 1952 (Annexure P-11).

The petitioner is seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus, without making a prayer before the concerned authorities.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach respondent No.1 at the first instance.

In case any such representation is made by the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today before respondent No.1-State of Punjab through its Principal Secretary of Health and Family Welfare, Punjab at Chandigarh, the same shall be decided by passing a speaking and well reasoned order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of representation.

The present petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
