Through this regular second, the appellant-defendant has laid challenge to judgment and decree dated 23.10.2018 of Ist Appellate Court, affirming judgment and decree of trial Court dated 26.07.2017, whereby suit for recovery of ₹3,81,936/- filed by respondent-plaintiff along with interest @ 9% per annum from the date of filing of suit till actual realization, was partly decreed.

The matter pertains to the year 2019 and notice is yet to be issued in the same.

Perusal of order-sheets shows that this case was taken up for hearing for 09 times, out of which on 05 dates i.e. 16.01.2023, 31.07.2023, 09.01.2024, 03.04.2024 and 07.08.2024, the same was adjourned at the request of learned counsel for the appellant in order to go through the lower Court records, prepare the case and address arguments.



Today, there is no representation on behalf of the appellants, despite the case having been called twice. Therefore, it can safely be presumed that the appellant or its counsel is no more interested in pursuing the present second appeal.
