1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking quashing of FIR No.182 dated 22.10.2024 under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B of IPC registered at Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 30.11.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. On 03.02.2025, the following order was passed:-

'This petition has been filed under Section 528 BNSS seeking quashing of FIR No.182 dated 22.10.2024 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran, on the basis of compromise dated 30.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioners refers to the vernacular of the FIR (supra) available at Page 25 of the paperbook and submits that the jurisdictional police authorities have registered the FIR (supra) against 07 accused persons and all the accused persons are impleaded as petitioners in the present case.

At this stage, on asking of the Court, Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 – State and Mr. D.S. Gandhi, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and files Vakalatnama, which is taken on record. Copy of the paper book be supplied to them during the course of day.

In the meanwhile, the parties are directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate within two weeks from today or any other date convenient to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, to get their statements recorded regarding compromise and after recording their statements, learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate is directed to send report regarding the genuineness of compromise and also to intimate whether any PO proceedings are pending against any of the party on or before the date fixed i.e. 03.03.2025.

A copy of the order be sent to learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate through fax for compliance.'

3. In compliance of the aforesaid order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.

4. In view of the compromise and the ratio of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466** and **Shakuntala Sawhney (Mrs) Vs. Kaushalya (Mrs.) and others (1980) 1 SCC 63** and Full Bench of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab 2007 (3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, this petition is allowed and FIR No.182 dated 22.10.2024 under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B of IPC registered at Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed, qua the petitioners.
