The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to provide all consequential notional benefits including pay fixation, seniority, gratuity and pension to the petitioners and step up their pay at par with their counterparts selected and appointed in 2004 pursuant to advertisement 05 of 2003, dated 18.09.2003. The petitioners were also selected in 2004, though their appointments were made in 2006.

2. It is not disputed that the petitioners have already approached this Court in earlier round of litigation which led to passing of judgment, dated 18.11.2022, in CWP-18043-2018 titled *Hitesh Kumar and others v. State of Haryana and others*, and connected cases. In compliance of the directions issued therein, the respondents granted some benefits to one of them vide office order dated 27.06.2024, Annexure P-14. Rest of the petitioners have again

approached this Court seeking a direction to give those benefits as have been given to one of them vide the aforementioned office order. Once the petitioners' rights have been determined in terms of the judgment rendered by this Court, dated 18.11.2022, the instant petition claiming other benefits in terms of an office order passed for one of the petitioners, dated 27.06.2024, is not maintainable. No new cause of action has arisen to them.

3. Further, learned State counsel has instructions to submit that office order dated 27.06.2024, is under review, and the petitioners will soon be released due benefits in terms of judgment dated 18.11.2022.

4. The petitioners are at liberty to avail the remedies available in law for execution of the judgment, if the benefits are not released.

5. Disposed of.
