Main case

1. This is a petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and his family.
2. Heard.
3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner, facing threat to his life and liberty had moved a



representation to the Superintendent of Police, Jind, dated 12.08.2024 (Annexure P-3) but the same is still pending consideration. He submits that, subsequently, the petitioner had moved separate representations to the Director General of Police, Haryana, ADGP, CID, Haryana, Inspector General of Police, Haryana, and IGP/Security, Haryana, dated 10.10.2024, (Annexures P-5 to P-8) respectively. But till date no action has been taken thereon.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to consider and dispose of the representation dated 10.10.2024 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

5. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Surender Singh, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice and submits that the aforesaid representation (Annexure P-5) dated 10.10.2024 shall be considered and disposed of in an expeditious manner in accordance with the law.

7. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-Director General of Police, Haryana, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 10.10.2024 (Annexure

P-5), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.
