1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 CrPC, praying for quashing of FIR No.0036 dated 05.03.2021 U/s 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC & Section 326 IPC added lateron, registered at P.S. Tanda, Distt. Hoshiarpur, and all consequential proceedings arising there from on the basis of Compromise Deed Dated 12.04.2024 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

2. Learned State counsel informs the Court that there are total 7 accused in the present case, and out of them, only 1 has filed instant petition, for seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

3. Further submits that in view of the judgment passed by the Division Bench of this Court in CRM-M-48043-2023, titled as *Rakesh Das vs. State of Haryana, 2024 NCPHHC 147654*, decided on 12.11.2024, partial quashing petition on the basis of compromise is not maintainable.

4. Considering the submissions addressed by learned State counsel, present petition is disposed of, as the same being not maintainable. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a fresh and comprehensive one, by impleading all the necessary parties i.e. all the accused as well as the complainant/victim(s), in the case.
