Present petition has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 seeking regular bail in FIR No.146 dated 14.09.2024, under Sections 109, 351(3), 191(3), 190, 111(2)(b) of BNS, 2023, Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 4, 5 of the Explosive Substance Act, 1908 (Section 61(2) of BNS, 2023 added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

2. Faced with the situation that PW – injured and PW – FIR/ complainant are yet to be examined as prosecution witnesses, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition in hand, at this stage. He has further submitted that the trial Court be directed to expeditiously record statements of the said two witnesses.
