Fourth petition has been filed under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS'), for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in FIR No.0038 dated 16.01.2022, under Sections 201, 302, 364 and 120-B read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Old Industrial Panipat, District Panipat.

2. In pursuance of order dated 20.05.2025, DNA report dated 25.05.2025 has been produced and taken on record as Mark 'X'. Learned State counsel also apprised the Court that costs of Rs.1 lakh has been deposited with learned trial Court.

3. After arguing for some time, when the Court was not inclined to accept the prayer, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, he wishes to withdraw the present petition, “at this stage”.

4. Disposed off accordingly.

5. Learned State counsel further apprised the Court that deceased is survived by three schildren, namely, Ravi (son-15 years), Anjali (daughter-14 years) and Ishu (son-12 years) and they are currently residing in the care and custody of their maternal grandmother Smt. Kela Devi (Mobile No.8053656267) wife of Randhir in village Babail, District Panipat. Thus, in the interest of justice and in order to safeguard the future of above three minor children, costs of Rs.1 Lakh, already deposited with learned trial Court be converted into three separate Fixed Deposits in a nationalized bank, fetching maximum rate of interest in their favour in equal shares, till they attain the age of 21 years, respectively.

6. It is clarified that all three children shall be entitled to get the maturity amount along with interest of their respective Fixed Deposit Receipts on attaining the age of 21 years by moving appropriate application(s) before learned trial Court.

A copy of this order be sent to Smt. Kela Devi, maternal grandmother of the children forthwith for necessary information.

7. It is also made clear that above observations be not construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the case, in any manner.
