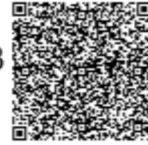

The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.15 dated 06.04.2023 registered under Sections 120-B, 409, 418, 420, 466, 467, 468, 471, 477-A IPC and Sections 13(2), 13(1)(b), 7, 8 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 registered at P.S. ACB, Gurugram.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 04.03.2025 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 04.03.2025 and is not required for custodial interrogation.
