1. Learned counsel for the respondent having received communication dated 13.02.2025 from the office of Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana has supplied a copy thereof to learned counsel for the petitioner giving details of payment of CPF Fund by the petitioners.
2. In response, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that necessary deposit in terms of the aforementioned communication shall be made by the petitioners within 10 days from today. To this, learned counsel for the respondent submits that from the date of deposit of the said amount by the petitioners, pensionary benefits including the GPF, if any, payable to the petitioners shall be released to them within 15 days thereafter.
3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by the respondent(s), learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition.
4. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
5. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
