This application is for placing on record the compromise deed along with original affidavit of respondent No.2 as Annexure P-4.

2. Heard.

3. For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and Annexure P-4 is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

Main case

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing of FIR No.360 dated 31.10.2024, under Sections 190, 191(2), 191(3), 324(4), 329(3) & 351(3) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Sonipat Sadar, District Sonipat and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 14.02.2025 (Annexure P-2) and the affidavit of respondent No.2 (Annexure P-4) whereby the

petitioners claim to have settled their differences with complainant/respondent No.2.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Ankita Ahuja, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

4. Mr. Rishabh Chaudhary, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and confirms the factum of the compromise having been effected between the parties and states that he has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the material available on record.

6. In that view of the matter, even if this case is taken to its logical conclusion, it would only be an exercise in futility as the parties have already settled their differences. Therefore, no purpose would be served in wasting the time and resources of the State in pursuing this case to its pre-ordained end. It would, therefore, be better to give a quietus to the issue at this stage.

7. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and FIR No.360 dated 31.10.2024, under Sections 190, 191(2), 191(3), 324(4), 329(3) & 351(3) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Sonipat Sadar, District Sonipat and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners shall stand quashed.
