1. Reply by way of an affidavit of Amritpal Singh, Sub Divisional Officer Punjab Mandi Board Amritsar-cum-Returning Officer of Gram Panchayat Sanghna, Block Atari Tehsil and District Amritsar has been filed on behalf of respondent No.4 in CWP No. 20789 of 2025 in Court today. The same is taken on record.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that keeping in view the settled principle of law settled by a Division Bench of this Court in **CWP No.2910 of 2021**, titled as **“Tanu Vs. State of Punjab and others”**, decided on 12.02.2021, as well as in **CWP No.26745 of 2024**, titled as **“Gurmail Singh Vs. State Election Commissioner and others”** and other connected cases decided on 14.10.2024, the present petitions may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further with liberty to file the election petitions before appropriate forum for the redressal of grievances raised therein.

3. Learned counsels for the petitioner(s) submits that the concerned respondents be directed to decide the election petitions expeditiously, so that the same do not become infructuous.

4. As, the election petitions are yet to be filed, in case the petitioners are aggrieved, that the same are not proceeding in a manner required, the liberty is granted to them to avail appropriate remedy for the redressal of the grievances at the relevant time.

5. The present writ petitions as prayed for are accordingly disposed of as not pressed with liberty to file election petition(s).
