The petitioner complains wilful disobedience of the following directions issued by the Court on 18.01.2024:-

“4. In view of the specific averments in para Nos. 6 and 7, wherein the respondents have submitted that as and when the petitioner will submit the requisite documents, the claim of the petitioners would be considered and a decision be taken in accordance with the policy notified by the respondent Distribution Licencee on 15.07.2019, counsel for the petitioner submits that he would have no objection in approaching the respondent authorities in terms of the applicable policy and for consideration of his claim.”

Learned counsel representing the respondents submits that an amount of Rs.12,70,802/- has already been released in favour of the petitioner through the following two cheques:-

i) Cheque No.060524 dated 28.10.2024 amounting to Rs.7,62,480/-

ii) Cheque No.071705 dated 09.05.2025 amounting to Rs.5,08,322/-

It is evident that the claim of the petitioner was required to be decided in accordance with the policy notified by the Distribution Licensee. Hence, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an application for revival, if the cause for filing the present petition survives.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
