

crystallized by the civil court of competent jurisdiction, they will not touch the said shops.

4. *Notice of motion for 28.01.2025*

5. *Mr. Pardeep Bajaj, D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab.*

6. *In the meantime, the petitioners are directed to join the investigation and to appear before the investigating agency, as and when called upon to do so. In the event of their arrest, they shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S., 2023. 7. Moreover, the petitioners are also directed to, at the time of joining investigation, furnish the written undertaking (supra) before the investigating officer.”*

3. Counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance to the said order, petitioners have already joined the investigation and have fully cooperated. Thus, he prays for confirmation of the interim bail order, by allowing the present petition.

4. On the other hand, learned State counsel files status report dated 25.01.2025, and confirms the statement made by counsel for the petitioners regarding joining of the investigation. He also submits that the statement of all the accused has already been recorded, during the course of the investigation.

5. Considering the totality of facts and circumstances detailed in the present petition and the fact that the petitioners have already joined the investigation, this Court deems it appropriate to allow the present petition. Accordingly, the ad-interim order dated 04.12.2024 is hereby made absolute.

6. However, the petitioners shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions laid down under Section 482(2) of BNSS.

7. Petition is disposed of.
