Present contempt petition has been filed alleging violation of interim order dated 29.1.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRWP-15-2025 titled as “Asha Devi vs. State of Punjab and others”, whereby it was directed that “...*In the meantime, the third respondent shall also ensure that no unauthorized police official enters the petitioner’s premises.*”

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that despite the above said direction the police had entered the house of the petitioner on 28.3.2025.

Learned counsel for the State refers to para 6(v) of the Status Report dated 03.7.2025 filed by way of affidavit of Shri Varun Sharma, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to submit that



the police party had entered the house of the petitioner on 28.3.2025 due to grave negligence and carelessness. Resultantly, departmental enquiry has been initiated against Sub Inspector Baljeet Singh No.59/Patiala and Sub Inspector Gurmeet Singh No.369/FGS, who have not been impleaded in the present contempt petition, vide Report of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Patran dated 13.6.2025 (Annexure R-1/T). Learned counsel for the respondent-State, further on instructions from Shri Inderpal Singh Chauhan, DSP, Patran and SHO Jaspal Singh submits that the said enquiry is likely to be concluded within six weeks.

Heard.

In view of the submissions made on behalf of learned counsel for the respondents, which are not being controverted by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present contempt petition is **disposed of.**

Rule stands discharged.
