The prayer in the present petition under Section 528 BNSS, 2023 is for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to constitute an Special Investigation Team (SIT) having members not below the rank of Superintendent of Police for conducting a fair and proper investigation in the present case.

2. The brief facts of the case as emanating from the pleadings are that the petitioner is serving as a Government Teacher in a School at Kartapur. She solemnized marriage with accused Kuldeep Singh on 15.04.2015 and two children were born from the said wedlock. On account of a matrimonial dispute, Kuldeep Singh and his family members caused injuries to the petitioner and her brother. An FIR No.06 dated 12.01.2025 under Sections 115(2), 126(2), 351(2), 190 and 191(3) BNS, 2023 P.S. Kartapur came to be registered at the instance of the petitioner. A cross-case came to be registered against the petitioner, her

brother and her father at the instance of her husband Kuldeep Singh. The instant petition has been filed seeking fair and proper investigation.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on account of the wealth and connections of the husband of the petitioner Kuldeep Singh, the Investigating Agency is not proceeding fairly and till date no challan has been submitted against Kuldeep Singh and others. The petitioner is being pressurized to compromise the matter. The occurrence of beating has been recorded in a CCTV camera. There is a video recording of a PCR coming to the house of the petitioner. An affidavit has also been prepared by a witness. The CCTV footage, the video footage of the PCR coming to the house of the petitioner, the affidavit etc. all have been given to the Investigating Agency but to no avail. Thereafter, an application has been moved before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural seeking proper investigation along with a prayer for the addition of the offences. As no action has been taken, the instant petition has been filed.

4. I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. Without going into the merits of the contentions raised by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural to look into the grievance of the petitioner and proceed in accordance with law.
