1. The instant petition has been filed for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for alleged willful disobedience the order dated 25.09.2024 (Annexure P-1), passed by the Writ Court in CWP-24706-2024, whereby, the following directions were passed:-

".....Thus, he submits that in such circumstances, it would rather be expedient if the petition is disposed of, at this stage, to enable the respondent authorities to consider the concerns/grievances of the petitioners and pass appropriate orders on their representation (ibid), in accordance with law. Further, he submits that before any such orders are passed, the petitioners or their authorized representative(s) shall be heard, for which, they may appear before the Estate Officer, EO HUDA, Gurugram-II, Sector-56, Gurugram, on 30.09.2024 at 11:00 A.M. And, accordingly, the necessary orders, as indicated earlier, shall be passed within three days thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is agreeable to the course suggested by learned counsel for the respondents and submits that let this petition be disposed of, in terms of the statement made by him.



In the wake of the position sketched out above, and in terms of the statements made by learned counsel for the parties, the petition is accordingly disposed of.

This Court is sanguine that the authorities shall look into the matter in the right earnest. And the appropriate orders, assigning reasons in support thereof, shall be passed within the time indicated by the learned counsel for the respondents.”

2. Compliance affidavit dated 02.12.2024 filed on behalf of the respondent along with Power of Attorney is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to the opposite counsel. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent submits that compliance of the order dated 25.09.2024 has been made by passing speaking order dated 29.11.2024 (Annexure R-1).
4. In view of the above facts and circumstances, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail alternate appropriate remedy, as per law.
5. Rule stands discharged.
6. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
