1. The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.172 dated 14.12.2024, under Sections 140(1) Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, (Section 364 IPC), Sections 103(1), 61(2), 190 & 191 (3) Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 Sections 302, 120-B, 149 and 148 IPC added lateron) registered at Police Station Ghall Khurd, District Ferozepur.

2. Allegations, in brief, are that Balbir @ Karan was kidnapped by some unknown persons and in supplementary statement, it came up that one Lovepreet Singh @ Manpreet Singh @ Manu and her son had come to meet one girl, namely Nisha, where he was kidnapped by Sunny, Gurnaib Singh @ Nikka, Resham Singh, Vicky and some unidentified persons. Nisha, co-accused, called the deceased at the spot from where he was kidnapped. During custody, name and role of the present petitioner have been cropped up as main accused and mastermind of the incident.

3. Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner as serious allegations are levelled against him with regard to the crime.

4. After hearing learned counsel for the parties, this court is of the opinion that no ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, at this stage.
