The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to decide the petitioner's case for promotion from the post of PTI to TGT Physical Education sent to the Director Elementary Education vide memo dated 28.02.2024.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case he is permitted to make a fresh representation before the second respondent raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents, and submits that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the same will be decided by the second respondent expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a representation before the second respondent/Director Elementary Education within a week



from today. In case any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the same shall be decided by passing a speaking order thereupon in accordance with law, within eight weeks of receiving the representation. In case he is found entitled for the promotion, necessary order to that effect will be passed within two weeks therefrom.

6. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
