1. The present appeal has been filed against the judgment and order of conviction dated 03.10.2006, whereby the appellant was sentence as under:

Offence	Sentence
Under Section 498A read with Section 34 IPC	All the three convicts to undergo rigorous imprisonment for two years each and to pay fine of Rs.5000/- each. In default of payment of fine, to further undergo rigorous imprisonment for six months.
Under Section 304-B IPC	Convict Sunil to undergo rigorous imprisonment for seven years and to pay fine of Rs.5000/-. In default of payment of fine, to further undergo rigorous imprisonment for six months.
All sentence shall run concurrently.	

2. In furtherance to the order dated 21.08.2025 learned State counsel has verified that the appellant-Sunil Kumar has since expired on 24.11.2017. Death Certificate has been filed, which is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for appellant submits that in view of the death of appellant, this appeal abates.

4. Appeal is disposed of accordingly.
