**HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)**

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from respondent No. 3-Sh. Deepak Patil Prabhakar, IFS, Deputy Conservator of Forests-cum-Divisional Forest Officer, Bhiwani, submits that a supernumerary post has been created for grant of benefit in favour of the deceased-employee/petitioner; consequent thereof, she has been granted the benefit of regularization w.e.f. 01.10.2003 and the financial benefits shall be released to the petitioner(s) within a period of four weeks from today.

[2] In view of the above undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[3] **Dismissed as not pressed.**

[4] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner(s) would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner(s) towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

[5] Rule stands discharged.

[6] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
