HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 13.05.1999 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Commissioner, Ferozpur Division, Ferozpur (in short 'Divisional Commissioner').

2. Learned counsel for respondent No. 2-Gram Panchayat submits that this civil writ petition has been rendered infructuous as Gram Panchayat has already taken possession of the land in question. It is further submitted that even otherwise, the instant civil writ petition has been filed against an interim order dated 13.05.1999 (Annexure P-3), passed by learned Divisional Commissioner on an application filed by Gram Panchayat for vacation of stay order.

3. On the other hand, learned counsel for petitioner submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to contact the petitioner and pleads no instructions in the matter.

4. In view of the above, this writ petition is dismissed for non prosecution.
