1. Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 (earlier Section 438 Cr.P.C.), is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who has been booked in a criminal case arising out of First Information Report, as detailed hereunder:-

2. Learned State counsel has filed status report dated 27.03.2025 in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

3. Learned State counsel refers to paragraph Nos.4 to 8 of the status report, along with the screenshots of the call details appended thereto, whereby it becomes abundantly clear that the relief sought by the petitioner in the present case is not substantiated. Furthermore, the

allegations are required to be verified through the custodial interrogation of the petitioner.

4. Sufficient facts are already available with the investigating agency, provided by the other accused involved in the incident, against whom serious allegations of smuggling drugs across the border have been made. The petitioner is one of the individuals, who is allegedly involved in picking up parcels of heroin that were received in the border area of the country via drones.

5. Since, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out, present petition is hereby **dismissed**.
