1. Learned State counsel has filed status report on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 3, in the Court, which is taken on record and refers to para 7 and 8 thereof, which read thus:-

“7. That it is humbly submitted that report No.154-24/DITAC has been received from Digital Investigation Training and Analysis Centre Punjab SAS Nagar relating to extraction of data from the mobile of the deceased Komalpreet Kaur has been received. The result of the examination given in the aforesaid report is as under:-

Result of Examination

The exhibits after proper process have been opened in the DITAC. The data available in the Exhibits under question has been extracted through Mobile data extraction tool.

Ex-1: The data from the Mobile phone Xiaomi could not be extracted as the Mobile Phone is password locked and not bypassed with the Mobile Data extraction Tools available in DITAC.

Ex-1(A): The data from the Nano Sim card of Jio has been extracted through supported extraction method i.e. Advanced Logical extraction method with UFED Cellebrite Mobile data extraction tool.

Printout of the extracted data is being provided (Page 01 to 03)

8. That it is humbly submitted that the allegations made by the petitioner are totally baseless, misconceived and devoid of truth. So far, the investigation of the case has been conducted in a through professional manner as per the standard procedures

envisaged under the Punjab Police Rules, 194 and BNSS without any prejudice, bias or ill-will.”

2. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed.
3. Disposed of, however, reserving the petitioner with a liberty to avail of alternate remedy that may be available to her, in accordance with law.
