1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to keep departmental proceedings in abeyance till the conclusion of investigation in FIR No. 29 dated 16.08.2024, under Section 7 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Ludhiana.
2. Mr. Balram Prashar, Advocate submits that respondents may be directed not to proceed with the departmental proceedings till the completion of investigation in the afore-stated FIR.
3. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab concedes that this Court in similar cases has directed to keep the departmental proceedings in abeyance till the completion of investigation in FIR.
4. Counsel for the petitioner agrees to the aforesaid arrangement.



5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the instant petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondents to keep the departmental proceedings in abeyance till the completion of investigation in the afore-stated FIR.
