**SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (ORAL)**

1. This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as 'BNSS') in case arising out of FIR No.57 dated 01.04.2025 under Sections 109, 61(2), 115(2), 126(2), 191(3), 190, 324 (4), 125 of the BNS and Section 25 of the Arms Act 1959, Police Station Division No.6, District Ludhiana.
2. Vide order dated 30.04.2025, the petitioner was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Investigating/Arresting Officer. The petitioner was also directed to cooperate with the Investigating/Arresting Officer.
3. On the instructions of SI Balwant Singh, who is present in Court, learned State Counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in view of the order dated 30.04.2025. He has further stated that the custody of the petitioner is not required for further investigation.
