As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for both the Insurance Companies (Respondents 3 and 6), separately recorded, a sum of Rs.8,00,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. As per statement, the entire enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1-Sarvesh W/o late Sh. Ajit Singh, for & on behalf of all the claimants, in full & final satisfaction of the claim. Learned counsel for the appellants has confirmed that the amount awarded by the learned tribunal has already been disbursed to the appellants.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to both the Insurance Companies (Respondents 3 and 6) to deposit two cheques in the sum of Rs.4,00,000/- each favoring appellant No.1-Sarvesh W/o late Sh. Ajit Singh with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of 02 months' from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheques/drafts from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopies of the cheques/drafts bearing signatures of the counsel for the appellants.

Pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, stands disposed of.
