1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.9 dated 19.03.2025 under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 126(2), 191(3), 190 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNS'), registered at Police Station Kabirpur (Ahalikalan), Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.
2. Learned State counsel, at the very outset, submits that during the investigation, the police has added offence under Section 118(2) of BNS, which has not been mentioned in the head note and prayer clause of this petition.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to file a fresh petition, after incorporating Section 118(2) of BNS (added later on), in the head note and prayer clause.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
