The present petition has been filed for seeking directions to the respondents to grant admissible pension to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent-UOI contends that the admissible pension has already been released to the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not dispute that the claim of the petitioner already stands accepted and disability pension has been granted to him, however, he contends that he may be granted permission to pursue his separate claim in case any benefit still remains unpaid to him.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent has no objection to the same.

The present petition is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to pursue the claim for any other relief that may have been left unpaid.
