Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 528 Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanita (BNSS), 2023, with a prayer for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to take necessary steps to the effect that there is no obstruction in plying of the vehicle of the petitioner and to take appropriate legal action against respondents No.4 & 5 who are trying to make an attempt to forcibly take away the vehicle of the petitioner bearing registration No. PB-02-DW-5697 with the help of recovery agents as the petitioner has already paid substantial loan amount.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the private respondents No.4 & 5, are attempting to forcibly take away the vehicle of the petitioner bearing registration No. PB-02-DW-5697 with the help of recovery agents, which is against the directions issued by the Supreme Court in *Citicorp Maruti Finance Ltd. Vs. S. Vijayalakshmi*



*2012(1) SCC 1* and in *ICICI Bank Ltd. Vs. Parkash Kaur and others (JT-2007(4) SC 39)*. It has been submitted that the matter was reported to respondent No.2 vide representation dated 10.12.2024 (Annexure P-2) seeking his help, however, it had been in vain. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into his representation dated 10.12.2024 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate steps at the earliest.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. H. S. Deol, Senior DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. In view of the above, without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the representation dated 10.12.2024 (Annexure P-2) qua the alleged attempt of forcibly taking away the vehicle of the petitioner and take necessary steps, as may be required, in accordance with law. However, this direction will have no effect on any civil or criminal action, which could be initiated in the matter in accordance with law.
