SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. The petitioner has filed this first petition for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 95 dated 17.07.2024, under Sections 21 (a)/22/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act (for short 'NDPS Act'), registered at Police Station, Subhanpur, District Kapurthala.

2. Custody certificate filed on behalf of the State is taken on record.

3. The petitioner is in custody since about 08 months and 04 days. He is alleged with the seizure of 1 gram of Heroin and 115 tablets of Alprazolam.

4. Though, the quantity of narcotic drugs, seized, is not commercial, but considering the fact that the petitioner has three similar cases of NDPS Act registered against him, two of

2017 and in the third case also arising out of the allegation under the NDPS Act, he has been convicted, this Court deems it appropriate that release of the petitioner would not be in the interest of justice, as there is possibility of petitioner fleeing from justice.

5. It would be appropriate to consider the bail application of the petitioner after the main witnesses are examined. With the aforesaid liberty, the petition stands dismissed.
