In pursuance to the order dated 25.04.2025, compliance reply by way of affidavit of Dr. Manish Bansal, Director General Health Services Haryana, Panchkula, has been filed in the Court today, which is taken on record. According to the reply, a fact finding enquiry report has been submitted before the government on 13.05.2025 for consideration and for taking strict action against the officers responsible for conducting re-examination of the medico legal case i.e. Dr. Hitesh Kumar, RMO, who constituted the second board without any specific orders of the competent authority as per medico Legal Manual, 2012 and the government has approved the departmental proposal on 16.05.2025.

Similarly, compliance report by way of affidavit of Anurag Rastogi, Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, has also been filed in the Court today, which is taken on record. Para 4 of the said compliance report, reads as follows:-

4. That after due consideration of the above report of the Divisional Commissioner, Faridabad, the following action have been taken:-

(i) Explanation of the SDM Badhkhal is being called to show cause as to why and how a clerk in his office has been authorized to dispose of fresh dak/papers at his own level without seeking his approval.

(ii) Besides, the Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad has been asked to initiate disciplinary action against Sh. Jaideep, Clerk office of SDM, Badhkhal for major penalty for the misconduct that he at his own without showing such important letters/requests to SDM, forwarded the same to CMO for necessary action.

(iii) The Additional Chief Secretary, Health Department has been requested vide letter dated 21.05.2025 to take disciplinary action against the CMO and any other officials, if found involved in the case.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be passed.

Disposed of accordingly.
