RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J. (ORAL)

1. Present petition has been filed praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.0127, dated 05.07.2024, under Sections 420 and 120-B of IPC, 1860 read with Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014, registered at Police Station Sadar Shri Muktsar Sahib, District Shri Muktsar Sahib. Further prayer has been made for staying the arrest of the petitioner during the pendency of the present petition.

2. Vide order dated 14.07.2025, while granting the interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.



3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 14.07.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

4. Learned counsel for respondent No2 has opposed the same.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

6. In view of the above, interim order dated 14.07.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.

7. Petition stands allowed.
