1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.107 dated 02.11.2024, under Sections 103, 109, 126(2), 191 (3), 190 BNS, 2023 and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda.
2. Vide order dated 07.08.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 07.08.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.



5. Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner. He submits that the petitioner had played an active role in the commission of the offence by forming an unlawful assembly.

6. In view of the above, interim order dated 07.08.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) B.N.S.S.

7. Petition stands allowed.

8. Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
