1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner for directions to the respondents No.2 and 3 to take action against the respondent No.6, who has issued a false medical report to the petitioner, regarding the pregnancy of his wife and against the respondents No.4 to 6, who have not taken any steps on the complaint, moved by him.

2. The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the petitioner has filed the representation dated 21.05.2025 (Annexure P-5) before the respondent No.2. The learned counsel prays for disposing of the present petition by issuing directions to the respondent No.2 to decide the abovementioned representation within a stipulated time.

3. Notice of motion to the respondents No.1 to 3 only.



4. Mr. Eklavya Darshi, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3, and waives service.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-5) by passing a speaking order within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of copy of instant order. It is however clarified that no finding is being returned, by this Court, with regard to merits of the contents of representation. The respondent No.2 shall be at liberty to make an independent assessment with regard to contents of representation of the petitioner and make an independent decision at his own level.
