Main case

1. The present Civil Revision has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 151 CPC for setting aside the impugned order dated 21.09.2024 (Annexure P-4), passed by the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali in the interlocutory application dated 25.08.2023.

2. As per the report dated 04.04.2025, received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the matter has been settled *inter se* the parties and a Settlement Agreement dated 04.04.2025 has been executed between them in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

3. Today, the learned counsel for the petitioner and the respondent, who is appearing in person, submit that all the terms and conditions of the said agreement are acceptable to the parties.



4. In view of the above, the present Civil Revision stands disposed of in terms of the compromise arrived at *inter se* the parties.
